The **Gabriele Pezzoli Trio** was formed in Lausanne in the early 2000s. Their debut album, *Improvviso*, brought them international recognition and initiated a busy live performance schedule. Over the past two decades, the trio has performed in major clubs and festivals across Switzerland, Italy, Germany, the Czech Republic, Finland, Estonia, Greece, and Madagascar.

JUNE, the trio's fourth album, continues the trajectory set by their previous works while exploring new ideas and embodying new influences. Drawing from their extensive experience in improvised music and electronic sounds, the group presents these elements in a purely acoustic format, featuring piano, double bass, and drums. **JUNE** thus stands as a recording that honors the rich tradition of the jazz piano trio while firmly situating itself in the contemporary music scene through modern inspirations, languages, and sounds.

Released in collaboration with the Swiss label Altrisuoni, the album features nine original compositions alongside two reinterpreted repertoire pieces, *Alfonsina y el Mar* and *Continuum*, which have been reworked and rearranged by the trio.
